
Luke 5:15-16





Moses prayed:

- ❖ Apostles = ones who are sent






Luke 6:14-16






Luke 6:17-18


Luke 6:20-21

for yours is the kingdom of God.


Blessed are you who hunger now,


**Those who sow with tears







the false prophets.”




Leon Morris:







2 Corinthians 4:16-17

is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.**




