
- ❖ Gabriel and Zechariah (1:5-25)

---


- ❖ The Bible is rooted in history and geography.

- ❖ God answers prayers, often in unexpected ways.





---


What good is it, my brothers and sisters,

---




**When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.**



---


**Listen to me, you islands;


**The word of the LORD came to me, saying,

---


In a loud voice she [Elizabeth] exclaimed:

---


Hail Mary, full of grace,




## Psalm 25:4-5

---


Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior,


yet I will rejoice in the LORD,


“From now on all generations will call me blessed,


“He has helped his servant Israel,

three months and then returned home.




