









When Jesus saw her, he called her forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity." Then he put his hands on her, and immediately she straightened up and praised God.




#### Luke 13:15-16

The Lord answered him, "You hypocrites!











- \* Jesus won an easy one-line victory with standard rabbinical "lesser to greater" (How much more?) argument.

## Luke 9:7-8




# Luke 13:32-33

































## Acts 15:19-20
