"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered.
"May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her.

# Can you pray Mary's prayer?

- \* Humble yourself.
- \* Give up control.
- \* Work through your doubt.
- \* Count the cost.

- \* It was always God's plan to include Gentiles.

## The Gospel of Luke:

- Synoptic (like Matthew and Mark), but also distinct
- \* 1/3 about women
- Major theme: liberation of the poor and oppressed

- \* Announced by angels
- \* Celebrated with song

- \* Gabriel to Mary (1:26-38)
- \* Mary visits Elizabeth (1:39-45)
- \* Mary's song (1:46-56)
- \* Birth of John the Baptist (1:57-66)

- \* Birth of Jesus (Luke 2)

## Gabriel's greatesthits:

- \* Daniel (Daniel 8:15-17)

### Luke 1:26-27

In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David.

### Luke 1:27-28

The virgin's name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you."

## Luke 1:29-31

Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name lesus."

### Luke 1:32-33

"He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end."

# II Samuel 7:11, 17

[Nathan to David]: "The LORD declares to you that the LORD himself will establish a house for you. . . Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever."

### Luke 1:42-43

In a loud voice she exclaimed: "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear! But why am I so favored, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"

### Luke 1:44-45

"As soon as the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. Blessed is she who has believed that the Lord would fulfill his promises to her!"
