What will we learn this week?

- Disciples are known by their faith, hope and love.
- Disciples make more disciples.
- Disciples are rescued by Jesus.

Remember the guide to reading the epistles:

- Read it through in one sitting.
- Remember that it is someone else’s mail.
- Look for the occasion.

- 1st letter—Christ is coming soon.
- 2nd letter—He’s not coming back as soon as you thought.
