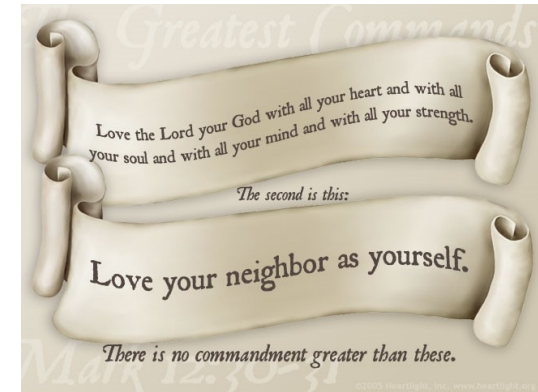

What does it mean to be part of a church family?

There are roles we are called to fulfill:

1. Disciple — cover today

- Bible study— personal and corporate
- Prayer — personal and corporate
- Community — Biblical friendship, e.g., small groups
 - ⇒ Iron sharpening iron
 - ⇒ Love at all times
 - ⇒ Closer than a brother.

Some attitudes/behaviors that will effect gospel power among us are:

- Free to keep keeping score
- Acceptance of refiner’s fire
- No need to be defensive
- Efficiency from staying in your lane
 - ⇒ Submission
 - ⇒ No “busybodying”
