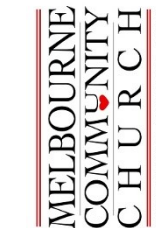

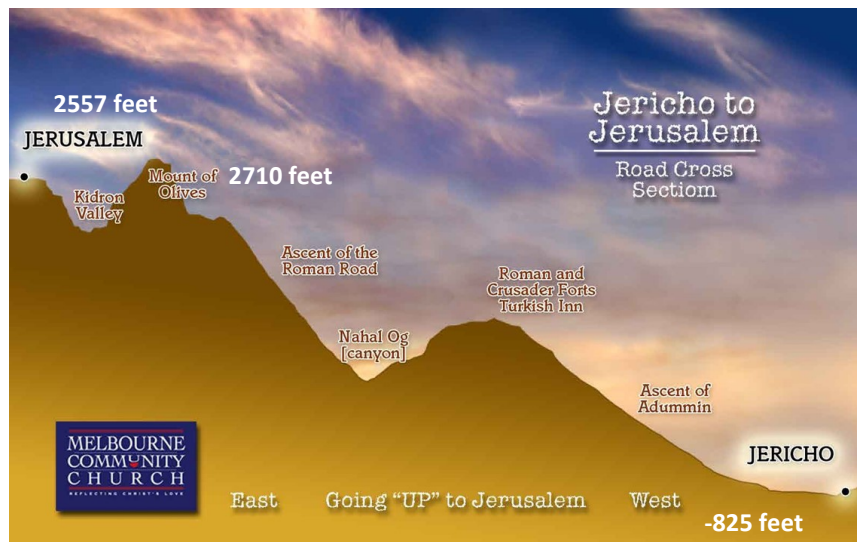
**What we learned last week: ([Matthew 10:1-23](#))**

Below is a time line of the leading up to the Last Supper, the Betrayal, and Good Friday with the western days of the week and the eastern Hebrew lunar calendar month (Nisan) and days.



Why does Jesus sending them ahead to get a donkey? How does Jesus know it would be there and what response the disciples were to give when asked? ([Zachariah 9:9](#); [Mark 11:1-3](#))

What was the meaning of Jesus riding on the donkey, and, with triumph, entering Jerusalem by the Golden Gate? ([Mark 11:7-10](#))

Do you think the leaders of the Jews knew what this meant?

Do you think the occupying Roman leaders and military took notice of the peoples reaction to Jesus’s entry into Jerusalem, especially their referring to the long honored King David? ([Mark 11:10](#))
