I said, "I will not again see the LORD himself in the land of the living; no longer will I look on my fellow man, or be with those who now dwell in this world.






I love the LORD, for he heard my voice; he heard my cry for mercy.


Because he turned his ear to me,

"LORD, save me!"







Psalm 116:8-9
