Wayne Gruden:

"Christians often talk about living with God 'in Heaven' forever, but in fact the biblical teaching is richer than that: it tells us that there will be new heavens and a new earth — an entirely renewed creation — and we will live with God there ... There will be a joining of heaven and earth in this new creation."

Two Heavens:

- Present Heaven (or intermediate Heaven)
- Eternal Heaven (or New Earth)

Revelation 21:1-2

Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

Revelation 21:3

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.

Anthony Hoekema:

"The 'new Jerusalem' ... does not remain in a 'heaven' far off in space, but it comes down to the renewed earth; there the redeemed will spend eternity in resurrection bodies. So heaven and earth, now separated, will then be merged: the new earth will also be heaven, since God will dwell there with his people.
