




#### Robert H. Stein:

"Questions involving the future coming of God's kingdom must not lose sight of the alreadynow dimension of the kingdom. Already now the kingdom has come, and the future not-yet dimension of God's kingdom will be shared only if one now enters the kingdom in its present manifestation."

















## 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14

# 1 Thessalonians 4:15-16


